2018 EARLY REGISTRATIONS ARE NOW OPEN

Washington, D.C. – The Institute of International Container Lessors (IICL) has announced that early registrations are being accepted for the 2018 Inspector Certification Examinations. With the early registration rate ending on 31 March 2018, IICL continues to receive inquiries from candidates all over the world.

The IICL Container and Chassis Inspector Certification Examinations will be <u>computer based</u> <u>examinations</u> provided at proctored test centers around the world, and each exam will consist of 100 multiple-choice questions in English. For the first time since its inception the examinations will be held twice in a calendar year. Each student will have the option to select a specific date between Saturday, 14 April 2018 and Sunday, 6 May 2018 for the spring examination and Saturday, 13 October 2018 thru Sunday, 28 October 2018 to participate in the fall examination.

These exams test the knowledge of an individual's ability to understand and interpret inspection and repair criteria for use in a wide range of practical applications throughout our industry. Candidates who pass the examinations will be awarded IICL certificates and will have their names listed in the IICL Online Inspection Directory for a five year period.

The 2018 Container examination is based on the Full Set of Container Inspection Publications (five manuals), The Convention for Safe Containers (CSC) Guide, and IICL Technical Bulletins 002 and 013. The Chassis examination is based on the Guide for Chassis Inspection & Maintenance, 4th ed., and IICL Technical Bulletins 018-022.
