The IICL is happy to introduce Mandarin as an additional language option to its Inspectors' Certification Exams. Starting on 6 December 2021 the IICL Inspector's Certification program candidates for reefer and dry van containers will be able to choose from one of three languages offered to take the exam at the time of registration. The Chinese version adds to the current Spanish and English versions and reinforces IICL's mission and commitment to facilitate the spread of professional education in the global container field.

With the support and assistance of its members, the IICL was able to expand and facilitate its industry accredited certification program to Chinese speaking candidates.
