### **IICL COURSES IN EUROPE**

**Washington, DC**—The Institute of International Container Lessors (IICL) will conduct both Flatrack and Dry Van Inspection courses in Antwerp, Belgium on 11 and 12 March 2009. This will mark the first time that IICL will conduct its flatrack course in Europe since the publishing of its “Guide for Flatrack Container Repair” manual that was released in March 2008. “We are grateful for the opportunity to offer our training programs to our partners in the container and inspection industry”, said Gary Danback, IICL’s Director of Technology.

The Flatrack Inspection course will be held on 11 March 2009. This one day course will offer intensive instruction of IICL Guides for Flatrack Container Inspection and Repair in addition to practical in-field presentations of flatrack inspection and repair methods. Experienced technical experts in the flatrack container field will lead the class.

The Dry Van Inspection course will be conducted the following day on 12 March 2009. This course will focus on understanding the IICL Guides for Container Inspection and Repair, in addition to practical in-field presentations of dry van inspection and repair methods. Particular attention will be paid to CSC and ACEP policies and procedures.

Both classes will be conducted at the Teveco NV Container Repair depot in order to maximize time spent reviewing damages, repairs and practical presentations.

The deadline for receipt at IICL of registrations and course tuition fees for the Antwerp, Belgium Flatrack and Dry Van courses is 2 March 2009. The tuition fee is US \$375.00 for the Flatrack and US \$400.00 for the Dry Van, payable by credit card, teletransfer or with a check (must be drawn on a U.S. branch or affiliate of your bank).
