Mr. Blust graduated, in 1971, from the U.S. Merchant Marine Academy at Kings Point, NY, and received a Master of Business Administration degree from Tulane University, in New Orleans, in 1979.

Mr. Blust stated that "I look forward to working with the IICL members and staff, the container transportation industry, governments, and trade associations, worldwide, in the pursuit of the IICL goals of providing technical support to the container industry and to increase the awareness of the importance of this great industry to efficient and safe global trade."
